CONVENIO N° 332-2016-MINEDU

INTER-INSTITUTIONAL COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

Between

THE UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE (A.B.N. 84 002 705 224) of Grattan Street, Parkville 3010 in the State of Victoria, a body corporate established pursuant to the University of Melbourne Act 2009, who is ranked in number 44, 33 and 33 in Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU), QS World University Rankings and Times Higher Education World University Ranking, respectively.

and

The Ministry of Education of Peru of Avenida Arequipa N° 1935, Lince, Lima 14 – Perú,, which is the governing body that is in charge of defining, directing and articulating policies regarding education, culture, recreation and sports in accordance with the general policies of the Peruvian Government, legally represented by the Executive Director of National Program of Scholarships and Educational Credit, hereafter PRONABEC, according to Resolution Ministerial N° 021-2015-MINEDU, which is the functional structure in charge of designing, planning, managing, monitoring and evaluating of scholarships and loans for higher education with the objective of contributing to equal opportunity in the access of professionals with insufficient income and academic excellence to graduate's study programs , as well as guaranteeing their permanence, culmination and obtaining of their corresponding titles.

(The Ministry)

1. Background

- A. To facilitate the upgrade of qualifications of Peruvian professionals, the Ministry through PRONABEC, provides a number of fully funded graduate scholarships to graduates to study at foreign universities.
B. The Parties agree to enter into this Agreement to set out the terms and conditions by which graduates supported by the Ministry, who satisfy the criteria set out in this Agreement and peruvian regulations, can study at the University.
C. The Parties will execute their common objectives in accordance with the terms set out in this Agreement.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE AGREEMENT

A. General Objective

Impulse the efforts of the Ministry in building advanced human capital through the awarding of scholarships for graduate studies programs in order to promote Peruvian's scientific, academic, economic, social and cultural development.

**B. Specific Objective**

Promote the access of Peruvian professionals with excellent academic performance and insufficient economic resources to graduate programs offered by the University and funded by the Ministry. These Master and Doctoral (Ph.D.) programs, mainly related to science and technology are specified in Annex 1 of this agreement.

The length of these Graduate Scholarships is determined by the graduate program of choice according to the parameters of the University

**3. Operative Clauses**

**3.1** The following principles are intended to govern the Inter-institutional relationships between the Parties.

**3.2** Each Party shall:

- (a) always act in good faith towards the other Party;
- (b) be accessible and communicate openly and honestly with other Party; and
- (c) work in a constructive and cooperative manner.

**3.3** In order to be eligible to receive the discount detailed in clause 4 against their Tuition Fees, a Awardee must:

- (a) be admitted to a Master or Doctorate (Ph.D) Program in the fields listed in Annex 1 after the Effective Date; and
- (b) be awarded a scholarship by The Ministry in 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018.

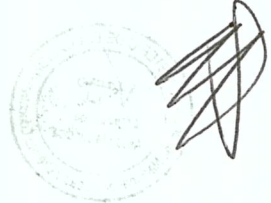
**4. DISCOUNT ON TUITION FEES**

**4.1** Subject to the terms of this Agreement, the University agrees to offer a discounted rate in respect of the Tuition Fees for PRONABEC's Awardees commencing a Program after the Effective Date.

**4.2** Without limitation to clause 3.3, the discount that the University will apply to the Tuition Fees for Coursework Programs and Research Training Programs is set at 10%.

**4.3** The discount will be applied to a PRONABEC Awardee's Tuition Fees throughout his/her enrolment in a Program, provided that:

- (a) Awardee commenced the Program after the Effective Date;
- (b) the PRONABEC Awardee's academic progress is satisfactory; and
- (c) the PRONABEC Awardee's enrolment does not exceed the duration applicable to that Program, as published in the *University Handbook* available at <http://handbook.unimelb.edu.au> and peruvian scholarships regulations (2 years Masters and 4 years PhDs)

## 5. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY INTO PROGRAMS

**5.1** All peruvian professional's application for admission to a Graduate Program offered at the University, must:

- (a) meet the academic and other entrance requirements of the Program to which they are applying; and
- (b) meet I.E.L.T.S. 6.5 level as English language proficiency requirements or Scores required for entry to graduate courses, which are located at <http://futurestudents.unimelb.edu.au/admissions/entry-requirements/language-requirements/graduate-toefl-ielts> only if these last are more exigent.

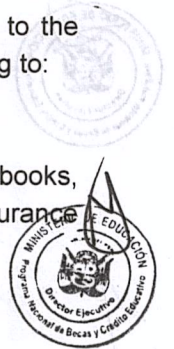
**5.2** Any PRONABEC Awardee admitted into a Program offered at the University will be responsible for:

- (a) enrolling at the University;
- (b) applying and paying for the appropriate visa required by the Government of Australia;
- (c) complying with all visa requirements
- (d) obtaining the appropriate overseas student health cover insurance required by the Government of Australia;
- (e) complying with the same University statutes, regulations and performance standards that pertain to University students;
- (f) providing the University with original or certified transcripts of their academic and English language results; and
- (g) covering any costs and expenses incurred while studying at the University, to the extent that the Scholarship or this Agreement does not cover the costs, relating to:
  - (i) any fees to the University; and
  - (ii) transportation to and from Peru, accommodation and living costs, textbooks, clothing and personal expenses, as well as, passport, visa and insurance expenses.

## 6. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

**6.1** The University will:

- (a) offer a 10% tuition fee discount in respect of the Tuition Fees for Awardees in receipt of a Ministry Scholarship, under this Agreement;
- (b) determine eligibility of Awardees for entry into a Program, subject to the University's policies on the admission and selection of Awardees, which are available at: <http://policy.unimelb.edu.au/MPF1035>;
- (c) advise the Ministry, in reasonable time prior to the commencement of each University academic semester, which Awardees have been accepted as eligible for entry into a Program;

- (d) undertake administrative procedures normally associated with the enrolment of international Awardees including invoicing of Tuition Fees to the Ministry prior to the due date for payment at around mid-February and mid-July each year, for semesters one and two respectively each year. The University will use its reasonable endeavours to send the academic report for each PRONABEC Awardees to the Ministry twice a year;
- (e) inform the Ministry the annual variation of tuition fees and the annual minimum Stipend set by the Australian Government to be paid to Awardees; and
- (f) provide Awardee access to a wide range of a services, including arrival assistance, Housing Services, Counselling, Health Service and language and learning skills support.
- (g) Every costs and fees to be paid by The Ministry are detailed in Annex 2. Annually in January, The University will inform the Ministry these costs and fees related to educational services provided to PRONABEC's Awardees.

## 7. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE MINISTRY

### Awardee application

7.1 In relation to a Awardee application, the Ministry will:

- (a) subject to clause 8, disseminate information about the Programs and promote details of the Programs to prospective Awardees; and
- (b) advise the University which of the Awardees (who have applied the University) are the recipient of the Scholarship.



### Awardee enrolment

7.2 In relation to a Awardee enrolment, the Ministry will:

- (a) Provide the University a letter signed by Executive Director, as responsible of scholarships administration of the Ministry, which includes the following information:
  - (i) a statement that the Awardee is a recipient of a Scholarship, and a statement of the value, term and composition of the Scholarship;
  - (ii) a statement that the Ministry will meet the liability for the payment of a Awardee's Tuition Fees and Stipend in accordance with this Agreement;
  - (iii) the name of the Awardee and the name of the Program in which he/she enrolled; and
  - (iv) a relevant contact person and address at the Ministry to which the University can direct queries to.
- (b) Provide the University with the PRONABEC's Awardee authorization (Annex 3) to provide his or her report or results to the Ministry.



### Tuition Fees and Stipend

7.3 The Ministry will pay:

- (a) the University, on behalf of the Awardee, the Tuition Fee. The University will invoice the Ministry for the Tuition Fees for a given semester; and
- (b) the Awardees' monthly Stipend. The University shall inform the Ministry, as soon as reasonably practicable, of the annual minimum Stipend set by the Australian Government through its Department of Education.

**8. CHANGES TO PROGRAMS, CURRICULUM OR SUBJECTS**

During the Term, the University may at its sole discretion make changes to any Program and selection and admission criteria to a Program, informing immediately the Ministry. Both parties must take necessary measures to avoid or minimize any prejudice, among themselves and PRONABEC's Awardees, caused by this decision, especially if PRONABEC's Awardees must change their Graduate Program or University.

**9. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

**9.1** Ownership of intellectual property created by PRONABEC's Awardees enrolled in University Programs will be governed by the University's statute and regulation on ownership of intellectual property. However, without this implying violation to intellectual property rights of the University, every article published by them, whilst they are enrolled at the University, must be clearly identified as made by a "PRONABEC's Scholarship Holder at the University of Melbourne

**9.2** Ownership of all rights, title and interests:

- (a) in the case of the University logo, remain vested with the University; and
- (b) in the case of the Ministry logo, remain vested with Ministry.

**9.3** The University grants to the Ministry a non-exclusive, royalty free licence during the Term to use the University logo for the purpose detailed in clause 7.1 (a), in a form approved by the University.

**9.4** The Ministry grants to the University a non-exclusive royalty free licence during the Term to use the Ministry logo in connection with this Agreement, in a form approved by the Ministry.

**9.5** For the purpose of this clause 9, each party agrees to provide the other party with an approved copy of its logo upon request.

**10. REPRESENTATIVE**

**10.1** During the Term, each Party shall nominate Representative(s) who will be responsible for:

- (a) managing or coordinating that Party's relationship with the other Party;
- (b) identifying any issues that arise between the Parties and referring those issues to the appropriate person within the Representative's organization;





- (c) discussing issues that may arise out of this Agreement with the Representative of the other Party; and
- (d) coordinating the exchange of relevant information between the Parties.

**10.2** Any notice, approval, consent, communication or exchange of information in connection with this Agreement must be marked to the nominated Representative, being:

**10.3** If there are any changes to the details of a Party's Representative in clause 10.2, that Party must promptly notify the other party of the change.

## 11. TERMS OF REVIEW, RENEWAL, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION

11.1 The Term of this agreement is four (04) years.

11.2 This Agreement commences on the Effective Date and continues for the Term unless terminated earlier (in accordance with clause 11.5).

11.3 The Parties agree to review the arrangements under this Agreement 12 months from the time of signing.

11.4 The Term of this Agreement can be extended by mutual written consent of the Parties.

11.5 This Agreement may be terminated early by:

- (a) either Party providing three (3) months written notice to the other Party's Representative; or
- (b) mutual agreement of the Parties.

## 12. EFFECT OF TERMINATION

12.1 If this Agreement is terminated early in accordance with clause 11.5:

- (a) The University will continue to provide a discount on Tuition Fees on the terms contained in clause 4 to Awardees who were enrolled in a Program at the University prior to the termination notice, for the duration of their Program; and
- (b) The Ministry will honour any financial letters, provided in accordance with clause 7.2, that it has provided in respect of PRONABEC Awardees enrolled prior to termination.
- (c) Decision shall become effective from the conclusion of the current academic period when being communicated the decision.
- (d) Resolution does not affect activities and obligations that parties are developing, which should continue to be met until complete implementation, as appropriate.
- (e) Both Parties will proceed to establish how much PRONABEC must pay to the University until current academic period finishes.
- (f) If PRONABEC Awardees do not want to change of university to complete their studies, the obligations will remain in force between the parties exclusively regarding these PRONABEC Awardees.
- (g) PRONABEC will not convene new scholarship Contests to send new Awardees to the University.
- (h) Parties shall take necessary measures to avoid or minimize any prejudice, between themselves and PRONABEC Awardees.

## 13. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

13.1 Each Party agrees to keep confidential and to ensure its employees, agents and subcontractors keep confidential, all Confidential Information:

- (a) provided by the other Party in connection with this Agreement, or





- (b) created by either Party under this Agreement; and
- (c) not to disclose such Confidential Information without the prior written consent of the other Party acting in its absolute discretion.

**13.2** Each of the Parties may disclose Confidential Information of the other:

- (a) to its officers, employees or contractors for the purposes of exercising its rights or performing its obligations under this agreement;
- (b) to the extent permitted by the terms of another agreement between them;
- (c) to the extent required by law, by a stock exchange or by a government or governmental body, authority or agency having authority over the party, provided that the disclosing party has first notified the other party that it is required to disclose the Confidential Information so that the other has an opportunity to protect the confidentiality of its Confidential Information; or
- (d) if required to do so in connection with legal proceedings relating to this agreement.

**14. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS**

**14.1** In carrying out obligations set out under this Agreement, each Party shall comply with all relevant laws, policies and requirements of the other Party as notified by the other Party from time to time.

**15. ESOS ACT**

**15.1** The Parties acknowledge that under Australian law, the University is required to be registered on **CRICOS** and to comply with the provisions of the ESOS Act and the National Code of Practice for Registration Authorities and Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students 2007 (**National Code**).

**15.2** The University agrees to provide the Ministry with the following:

- (a) Information regarding course materials, entry requirements, information on visa application and Overseas Student Health Cover that apply to the Student Exchange Program;
- (b) Melbourne's CRICOS provider code, which is 00116K ("**CRICOS Provider Code**"); and
- (c) Any other information that may be required from time to time.

**15.3** For the purposes of compliance with the ESOS Act and National Code, the Ministry must:

- (a) Distribute the information in the form provided by University (as set out in clause 15.2) to Awardees;
- (b) Ensure that the University's name and CRICOS Provider Code are clearly identified on all material distributed to Awardees, including electronic forms; and

- (c) Use its best endeavours not to engage in conduct that may cause the University to be in breach of the ESOS Act, including providing Awardees with inaccurate information about studying at the University.

**16. PERUVIAN LAW**

**16.1** According to Law 29837, that creates PRONABEC, and its Regulation, approved by Supreme Decree N° 013-2012-ED and modified by Decree Supreme N° 008-2013-ED, dated September 21, 2013, in postgrade studies, the Ministry:

- (a) Only may finance graduate studies for professionals with high academic performance and insufficient economic resources in Eligible International Higher Educational Institutions and Universities whom must be ranked among the first four hundred (400) at least once in the five years prior to the respective call in the following rankings: QS World University Rankings, Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU), Times Higher Education World University Rankings, and focusing on studies related to peruvian scientific and technological development
- (b) funds the following concepts:
  - tuition, pension, study materials, language course up to ten weeks when appropriate; insurance with health, accident, life and repatriation coverage, research work, certification (administrative costs for obtaining the relevant degree or equivalent), monthly allowance for food, lodging and local transportation and others PRONABEC be determined by the rules of each call, as budget availability; international transport (only at the beginning and end of the academic program).
- (c) cover the costs of the concepts indicated in 7.3, except the repetition of unapproved courses. This financing is granted according to the budget assigned annually by the Peruvian Public Budget Laws, the Law N° 28411 – General Law of the National Budget System of Peru, and "Subsidies's Execution Rules for Studies Abroad" of PRONABEC.

**17. WARRANTY AND INDEMNITY**

**17.1** The University:

- (a) warrants that it is the owner of the University logo and use by the Ministry of the University logo will not breach the intellectual property rights of any person; and

Indemnifies the Ministry against all expenses, losses, damages, costs, claims, suits and proceedings sustained or incurred by the Ministry arising from improper use of the Ministry logo.

**17.2** The Ministry:

- (a) warrants that it is the owner of the Ministry logo and use by the University of the Ministry logo will not breach the intellectual property rights of any person; and
- (b) Indemnifies the University against all expenses, losses, damages, costs, claims, suits and proceedings sustained or incurred by the University arising from improper use of the University logo.

**18. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES**

18.1 This Agreement does not create a relationship of employment, trust, agency or partnership between the Parties.

**19. MISCELLANEOUS**

19.1 Any reference to monetary values, including "\$", "AUD", or "dollars" is a reference to the lawful currency of the Commonwealth of Australia and any payments required under this Agreement are for an amount in that currency.

19.2 This Agreement may be altered only in writing signed by each Party.

19.3 Neither Party may assign this Agreement or a right under this Agreement unless it has the prior written consent of the other Party.

19.4 Each Party must do, at its own expense, everything reasonably necessary (including executing documents) to give full effect to this Agreement.

19.5 This Agreement is written in two sets of three original copies each, one in English and one in Spanish, both originals and equal in content and authenticity; and any schedule, attachment, annexure, amendment or variation to it must also be written in English and Spanish.

**20. DEFINITIONS**

20.1 In this Agreement, the following definitions apply:

**Agreement** means this Inter-Institutional Collaboration Agreement, together with any Schedules, Annexures and other documents incorporated by reference.

**Confidential Information** means information that:

- (a) is by its nature confidential;
- (b) is designated by the Parties as confidential; or
- (c) the Parties know is confidential and includes without limitation the terms of this Agreement and all information about the Parties, their employees, agents, policies and operations which is made available or which becomes known during the Term of this Agreement or as a result of executing this Agreement.

but does not include information which:

- (i) is or becomes public knowledge other than by breach of this agreement; or
- (ii) has been independently developed or acquired by either Party.

**Coursework Program** means a program of study leading to an award of the University that comprises more than one third of coursework. Coursework usually involves attendance at lectures, classes or seminars.

**Effective Date** means the date the last Party signed the Agreement.

**ESOS Act** means the Educational Services for Overseas Students Act 2000 (Cth).

**National Code** means the National Code of Practice for Registration Authorities and Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students.

**Program** means a graduate Coursework Program or graduate Research Training Program offered at the University to which a discount is applied against the Tuition Fees under this Agreement.

**Party** means a Party to this Agreement and **Parties** has a corresponding meaning.

**PRONABEC Awardee** means a professional Peruvian citizen who is a recipient of the Scholarship, and is enrolled in a Graduate Program at the University of Melbourne.

**Representative** means an employee of either Party appointed to act as its representative in relation to this Agreement as set out in clause 10.

**Research Training Program** means a program of study leading to an award of the University that comprises a minimum of two thirds of research, research training and independent study.

**Scholarship** means a scholarship awarded to a Peruvian citizen by the Ministry.

**Stipend** means the accommodation and living allowances provided to the PRONABEC's Awardee to study at the University:

- (a) in the case of a Coursework Program, Awardees must at the commencement of each year in which the Program is undertaken declare that he/she has sufficient funds to live and study in Melbourne Australia. The web link below provides the estimated costs for living in Melbourne in Australia but each Awardee must consider his/her own individual circumstances. The web link for estimated costs can be found at: [http://services.unimelb.edu.au/finaid/planning/cost\\_of\\_living/summary](http://services.unimelb.edu.au/finaid/planning/cost_of_living/summary) (or as amended from time to time); and
- (b) in the case of a Research Training Program, as set by the Australian Government (through the Department of Education) at the prevailing level of the Australian Postgraduate Award stipend, the value of which is set each year by the Australian Government, and which is available at: <https://education.gov.au/australian-postgraduate-awards>.

The Stipend amounts set out in sub-clauses (a) and (b) above are indicative and will change from year to year during the term of this Agreement.

**Term** means the term specified in clause 11.1 from the Effective Date.

**Tuition Fees** means the annual amount payable to the University for enrolment in a Program, as set each year.

In absolute conformity, THE PARTIES proceed to subscribe this agreement in two sets of 03 original copies each, one in Spanish and the other in English and both equal in content and authenticity.
