**AGREEMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL INTERINSTITUTIONAL COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION OF PERU AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TASMANIA, AUSTRALIA**

This document is the Agreement for International Interinstitutional Collaboration for the implementation of Graduate Scholarships between **THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION OF PERU**, with RUC N° 20131370998, with address for the purpose of this agreement in Avenida Arequipa N° 1935 – Lince – Lima 14 – PERU, represented by the Executive Director of the National Program of Scholarships and Educational Credit, hereafter PRONABEC, Dr. Raúl Choque Larrauri, identified with D.N.I. N° 23266921, appointed by Ministerial Resolution N° 161-2015-MINEDU and appropriately authorized to celebrate this agreement as stated in the Ministerial Resolution N° 021-2015-MINEDU, and **THE UNIVERSITY OF TASMANIA** with address Office of the Pro Vice-Chancellor, Private Bag 3, University of Tasmania, Hobart, 7001, TASMANIA, Australia, and with address in Peru for purposes of this agreement in Latino Australia Education S.R.L., Calle Monte Grande 120 Oficina 219 C.C Chacarilla - Santiago de Surco - Lima - Peru, hereafter **THE ENTITY**, represented by the Pro Vice-Chancellor, (Global Engagement), Prof Peter Frappell, who is appropriately authorized to celebrate this agreement according to University delegation, under the terms and conditions expressed as follows:

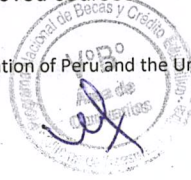
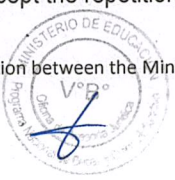

**FIRST: THE PARTIES**

- 1.1 The Ministry of Education of Peru is the body of the National Government that exercises the stewardship of the Education Sector and the competition in education field, sports and recreation, being responsible for formulating national and sectorial policies, in harmony with the development plans and general policy of the Peruvian State.
- 1.2 PRONABEC, is the Executive Unit N° 117 of The Ministry of Education of Peru whose function is designing, planning, managing, monitoring and evaluating of scholarships and educative credits for higher education with the objective of contributing to equal opportunity in the access of low income students and professionals with academic excellence to study postgraduate programmes as well as guaranteeing their possibilities to carry out the studies and obtaining the respective degrees or titles.
- 1.3 PRONABEC subsidizes:
  - 1.3.1 Graduate studies for professionals with high academic performance and insufficient economic resources in Eligible International Higher Educational Institutions and Universities whom must be ranked among the first four hundred (400) at least once in the five years prior to the respective call in the following rankings: QS World University Rankings, Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU), Times Higher Education World University Rankings, and focusing on studies related to Peruvian scientific and technological development.
  - 1.3.2 Tuition fees, study materials, English language course, if necessary, maximum 10 weeks; insurance with health, accident, life and repatriation coverage, research work, certification (administrative costs for obtaining the relevant degree or equivalent), monthly allowance for food, lodging and local transportation and others than PRONABEC determines by the rules of each call according to budget availability; international transport (only at the beginning and end of the academic program), except the repetition of unapproved courses.

1.4 THE ENTITY is one of the top 10 research universities in Australia and ranked in the top 2% of universities worldwide by the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) in 2013. THE ENTITY has outstanding links with universities, research institutes and industry across the globe.

In 2012 University of Tasmania research received the highest possible rating of 5, reserved for outstanding research by the Excellence in Research for Australia (ERA), in nine specific discipline areas: Clinical Sciences; Analytical Chemistry; Geology; Oceanography; Ecology; Evolutionary Biology; Plant Biology; Forestry Sciences; Agriculture, Land and farm Management.

**SECOND: BACKGROUND**

The Agreement of International Interinstitutional Collaboration, between PRONABEC and THE ENTITY, exercises the intention of the parts to strengthen their efforts to increase the offer of graduate scholarships with the objective of boosting the human capital with an adequate training, refinement and research promoting competitiveness and scientific and technological development for Peru.

**THIRD: LEGAL FRAMEWORK**

- 3.1. Law 29837 creates the National Program of Scholarship and Educative Credit – PRONABEC, modified by Law 30281.
- 3.2. Supreme Decree N° 013-2012-ED approves the Rules and Regulations of the Law 29837, modified by Supreme Decrees N° 008-2013-ED and 001-2015-MINEDU.
- 3.3. Ministerial Resolution N° 0108-2012-MINEDU approves the Operations Manual of PRONABEC.
- 3.4. Ministerial Resolution N° 021-2015-MINEDU, Delegation of Powers to PRONABEC CEO to sign this kind of agreements.

**FOURTH: GENERAL OBJECTIVE**

The general objective of this agreement is to impulse the efforts of The Ministry of Education of Peru in building advanced human capital through the awarding of scholarships for graduate studies programs in order to promote the scientific, academic, economic, social and cultural development of the country.

**FIFTH: SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE**

To promote the access of Peruvian professionals with excellent academic performance and insufficient economic resources to the graduate programs offered by THE ENTITY through the financing, by PRONABEC, of up to 50 students every year in Master and Doctoral programs related to Science and Technology.

The length of the Graduate Scholarships is determined by the program of choice according to the parameters of THE ENTITY in relation to the Master and Doctorate programs specified in Annex 1 of this agreement, according to prioritized fields previously mentioned, up to 2 (two) years for Masters and up to 4 (four) years for Doctorates

**SIXTH: COMMITMENTS OF THE PARTIES**

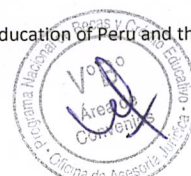
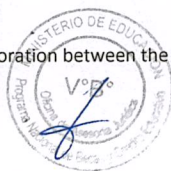
**6.1. COMMITMENTS OF THE ENTITY**

THE ENTITY assumes the following commitments:

- 6.1.1. Grant a corporate rate to fellows of application costs, registration, tuition fees, and educational services provided by THE ENTITY of 10% discount in Masters and 25% discount in Doctorate studies to fellows of PRONABEC, as indicated in Annex N° 2 of this agreement. Annually, at the beginning of fiscal year, THE ENTITY will inform PRONABEC of these costs, which are the lowest unsubsidized of THE ENTITY.
- 6.1.2. In addition to the annual stipend paid to each research scholarship holder by PRONABEC, the Entity will provide an additional monetary contribution to bring the annual stipend up to the equivalent of the Tasmanian Graduate Research Scholarships stated by the Graduate Research Office, University of Tasmania.
- 6.1.3. Grant the acceptance admission letter to every student that approved the admission's requirements or examinations, including necessary English level, in order to fulfill one of the prerequisites to obtain a scholarship awarded by PRONABEC for Master and Doctorate.
- 6.1.4. Facilitate the documentation needed to obtain the Student Visa for the entire length of the Master or Doctorate chosen by the candidate. This visa, after reaching its title shall not be renewed for any reason, because of the obligation of the fellows to return to Peru to reverse in their region of origin the knowledge acquired.
- 6.1.5. Provide tutoring and academic mentoring as well as support to the Scholarship awardees during their studies period.
- 6.1.6. Send to PRONABEC, at the end of each academic period, attach to the invoice to registration of the next academic period a complete report on the academic progress and disciplinary status of each Fellow based in:
  - Academic Report of the academic period concluded.
  - Report Academic enrolment period beginning.
 The ENTITY must report on the subjects required to complete the degree, including any failed subjects that need to be repeated.
- 6.1.7. Provide to each scholarship holder, English immersion classes at the Language Center of THE ENTITY, prior to their graduate studies if required for up to 10 weeks free of charge for Masters and doctorate students.
- 6.1.8. Provide information about the Master and Doctorate academic programs officially accredited internationally.

- 6.1.9. Provide to PRONABEC, the assistance to install in the institutional electronic portal of PRONABEC a direct link to the website of THE ENTITY in order to facilitate the access to the information concerning the Master and Doctorate offered by THE ENTITY, stated in Annex 1 of this agreement.
- 6.1.10. Provide information and advice to the fellows for their access to food and / or lodging.
- 6.1.11. Facilitate to scholarship holders starting their research work from the beginning of their studies in order to have it done by the end of their academic program and achieve their respective title.
- 6.1.12. Facilitate a well-equipped research space to each scholarship holder of PRONABEC in order to guarantee the normal development of their research activities.
- 6.1.13. Not enroll in the next academic term the fellow who scored average disapproval (causal loss of scholarship) and immediately inform Pronabec to take action to the repatriation of the fellow.

**6.2. COMMITMENTS OF PRONABEC**

PRONABEC, commits to:

- 6.2.1. Cover the total/tuition costs of each Peruvian scholarship holder as indicated in 6.1.1 and 6.1.6. The respective invoice will be paid via disposition of funds through the Integrated Financial Management System (SIAF in Spanish initials) of the Peruvian State to the bank account indicated by THE ENTITY. Cancellation shall take place within the time limits and procedures established by the parties in Annex 2 of this Agreement and subject to the PRONABEC's Rules for Execution of Subsidies abroad.
- 6.2.2. Grant an stipend for the concept of living expenses.
- 6.2.3. Grant an stipend for the concept of academic materials.
- 6.2.4. Provide roundtrip flight tickets to each scholarship holder; Lima – Tasmania (at the beginning of the academic program) and Tasmania – Lima (at the end of the academic program).
- 6.2.5. Cover the degree certification costs.
- 6.2.6. Provide insurance with health, accident, life and repatriation coverage to each scholarship holder during their stay in THE ENTITY.

**6.3 COMMON COMMITMENTS**

- 6.3.1. Elaborate a joint work plan every year aiming to achieve the objectives of the commitments contemplated on this agreement.
- 6.3.2. Evaluate and inform the results of the cooperation achieved, identifying the inconveniences and the possible improvements in the execution of this agreement.

**SEVENTH: THE FINANCING**

PRONABEC will cover the costs of the concepts indicated in numeral 6.2, except the repetition of unapproved courses, and THE ENTITY will assume the costs indicated in numeral 6.1 of the Sixth Article, with the objective that the Peruvian scholarship holders can access, stay and finish their studies in THE ENTITY and the discipline of their degree. The financing corresponding to PRONABEC is granted according to the Budget assigned annually by the Public Budget Laws of the country and the Law N° 28411 – General Law of the National Budget System of Peru.

**EIGHT: INTERINSTITUTIONAL COORDINATION**

For the adequate follow up, supervision and monitoring in compliance of the commitments established in this agreement, the parties agree to assign as Inter institutional Coordinators, according to the functions exercised in the implementation of this agreement, the following officials:

**For THE MINISTRY**

- Responsible : Executive Director of PRONABEC
- Alternative : Chief of the Post Graduate Scholarships Office of PRONABEC.

**For THE ENTITY**

- Responsible : Pro Vice-Chancellor, Global Engagement
- Alternative : Regional Development Manager, Americas and Europe

PRONABEC and THE ENTITY shall substitute their inter-institutional coordinators when considered appropriate. The substitution must take effect starting the seventh day after the reception of the letter of substitution given by the counterpart.

**NINTH: LENGTH OF THE AGREEMENT VALIDATION**

The length of validation of this agreement is (03) three years, starting from the date of signing.

**TENTH: AGREEMENT MODIFICATIONS**

Any modifications, restrictions, broadening or extension of this agreement can be done through mutual consensus of the parts and must be formalized by Addendum which will become part of this agreement.

**ELEVENTH: SOLUTIONS TO CONTROVERSIES**

Any controversies, discrepancies or demands derived from this agreement, including the ones concerning its expiration, nullity, execution, compliance or interpretation shall be settled by THE PARTIES through mutual consultation acting in good faith and in accordance to their common objectives.

**TWELVETH: FINAL DISPOSITIONS**

12.1. The parties subscribing this agreement, expressly state that this agreement is subject to Peruvian law, Tasmanian State law and the agreements contained in this document which are law between the parties and that their respective residences are the addresses mentioned in the introduction to this document, in which each other will be passed validly communications and / or notifications as necessary. Any variation of these addresses will be effective the tenth business day of being notified in writing to the other party.

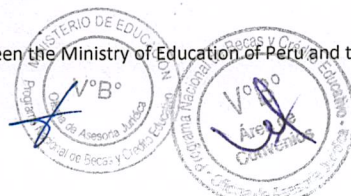
12.2. All communications shall be valid and effective if done writing, sent and received via fax, institutional e-mail, certified mail or notarized communications, remitted between those who subscribe this agreement and between Inter Institutional Coordinators, designated at the eighth clause.

12.3. This Agreement may be terminated by either party. As such:

- a. The decision shall become effective from the conclusion of the current academic period when being communicated the decision.

- b. The resolution does not affect the activities and obligations that the parties are developing, which should continue to be met until complete implementation, as appropriate.
- c. They proceed to settle and pay the costs incurred by PRONABEC until end of current academic period.
- d. If fellows do not see for appropriate transfer to another university to complete their studies, the obligations will remain in force between the parties exclusively regarding these fellows, not making new calls for scholarship contest that aim to send new trainees bound for THE ENTITY.
- e. The parties shall take the necessary measures to avoid or minimize any prejudice, both among themselves and fellows.

12.4. The intention of the parties is that the terms of the agreement are not enforceable in a court of law.

In absolute conformity, the parties proceed to subscribe this agreement in two sets of 03 original copies each, one in Spanish and the other in English and both equal in content and authenticity.
