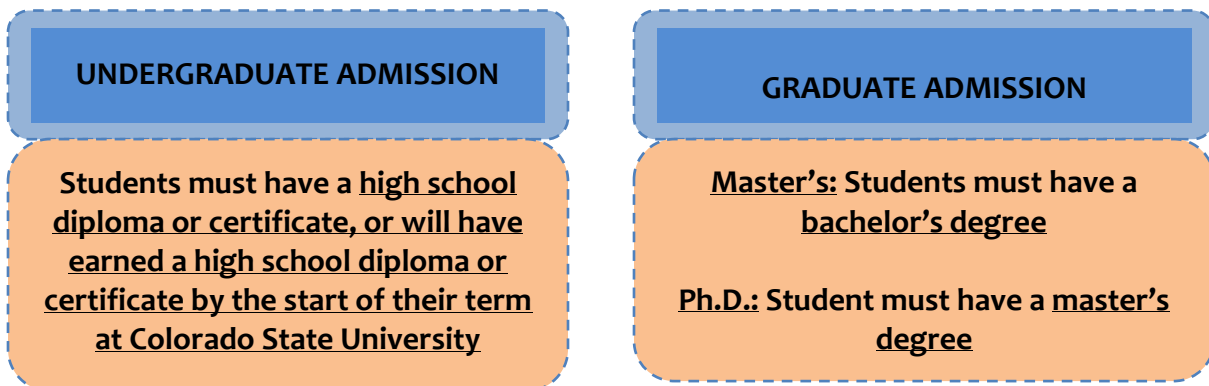

4. Have the ability to ‘think outside the box,’ exhibit critical thinking skills, and have a quest for discovery or investigative learning.
5. Demonstrative the ability to lead and inspire others.
6. Be a young professional who has developed or in the process of developing a small or medium enterprise in the Caribbean.
7. Have a strong background in business management.
8. Be proficient in English.
9. Commit to at least 4.5 hours a week to the course over a one-semester period that will consist of synchronous (live) and asynchronous content.
10. Have access to a computer with a reliable Internet connection, with appropriate video and audio functions.

Have completed or in the final years of an undergraduate business management program at an accredited institution or have at least a minimum of four (4) GCE or equivalent A’ Level passes plus two years of relevant business management experience.
