Dear Ms. Lorena Neilson Candia,

On 4 June 2026, the Board of Trustees of Tempus Public Foundation decided on the distribution of Stipendium Hungaricum scholarships for the academic year 2026/27.

We are pleased to inform you that, as a result of the decision, among the **7** nominees on your list, the scholarship application of **4** students have been approved by the Tempus Public Foundation from Pacific Alliance for studies starting in the 2026-2027 academic year.

The total number of scholarships awarded to citizens of Pacific Alliance has been determined within the Programme's existing budget, based on the performance of the applicants and the number of available places.

We would like to thank you for all your support during the application process and your active assistance of the scholarship holders during the following steps.

Awardees - visa application process

Please note that the attached list includes all nominated applicants who were awarded the scholarship. Tempus Public Foundation will inform the scholarship holders about their application results in the upcoming days and request them to start their visa application process as soon as possible. We kindly ask you to assist the awarded candidates with any support that might be necessary from the Sending Partner. Please note that the responsible Hungarian Embassy/Consulate and the Hungarian host institutions have also been informed about the incoming students.

We would also like to kindly remind you about the essential steps leading to the launch of the visa application process for the scholarship holders:

- Firstly, the applicants are required to accept the scholarship offer in the online application system which will be followed by the Hungarian host institution issuing a "Letter of Admission" document for the visa application process.
- Secondly, applicants with conditional status can also proceed to the acceptance or demission of their scholarship. At the same time, these applicants must complete both steps (i.e. submit their missing documents, if available, and accept their offer) until the deadline. In certain cases, it is expected that the date of the final exams or the issuance of certificates will be postponed, and graduates will not be able to receive them until the deadline. In this case, the relevant Sending Partner/Ministry shall confirm the situation and send an official ministerial certificate to the Tempus Public Foundation, who will inform the institutions (please note that a simple email message is not acceptable). You have previously been informed regarding our

procedure in case the degree and final exam certificates are issued after the submission deadline. In case of any change that influences the issuance of certificates in your country, please inform us.

- Finally, the official “Letter of Award” will be sent to them via the online system and by email. The “Letter of Award” issued by Tempus Public Foundation is to certify the scholarship status and is also necessary for the visa process.
- Awardees should wait to receive the Letter of Acceptance and the Letter of Award to start the visa process.

Visa procedure and entry regulations

We kindly ask you to make sure that all successful applicants start their visa application as soon as possible. Taking these next steps now is a key element of the process so that the scholarship holders can begin their studies in Hungary on time. Also, please inform successful applicants that they are advised to contact Hungarian Consulates as soon as possible to receive information on the current entry regulations. If the consular services are not present in your country, please contact us for further assistance.

The acceptance of the scholarship in the DreamApply online application system

We would also like to draw your attention to the importance of accepting the scholarship by the applicants in the DreamApply online application system. In case they contact you, please remind them of the following:

- Applicants are required to accept the scholarship in the online system **within 1 week from receiving the scholarship offer.**
- Applicants with a conditional status must upload the missing documents to the DreamApply online system as soon as they receive them, even if they have sent their documents earlier to the universities via email.
- Applicants have to finalize all administrative tasks mentioned above by 1 August 2026 at the latest; otherwise, they cannot be awarded the scholarship.

Please note that you can also review the above-mentioned process in the DreamApply system.

Mandatory medical certificate:

Scholarship holders do not need to upload the mandatory medical certificate to the online system, but they must bring it to Hungary and present it with the attachments during the compulsory medical examination in Hungary. This document is mandatory for those who will receive a scholarship. Medical examinations (free of charge for scholarship holders) are organized either by the universities or by private medical providers. Regarding the details, the scholarship holders will receive information after they arrive in Hungary (at the end of October, earliest), and we ask them to follow the instructions given to them. If they lack any vaccinations mandatory in Hungary, they will have the possibility of receiving them in Hungary.

Provisions covered by the scholarship:

- Tuition-free education
 - o exemption from the payment of tuition fee
- Monthly stipend (while staying in Hungary in accordance with the Operational Regulations)
 - o non-degree, bachelor, master and one-tier master level: monthly amount of HUF 43,700 (cca EUR 110) contribution to the living expenses in Hungary, for 12 months a year, until the completion of studies
 - o doctoral-level: according to the current Hungarian legislation, the monthly amount of scholarship is HUF 140,000 (cca EUR 355) for the first phase of education (4 semesters) and HUF 180,000 (cca EUR 460) for the second phase (4 semesters) - for 12 months a year, until completion of studies
- Accommodation contribution
 - o free dormitory place or a contribution of HUF 40,000 (cca EUR 100) to accommodation costs for the whole duration of the scholarship period
- Medical insurance
 - o health care services (national health insurance card) and supplementary medical insurance for up to HUF 65,000 (cca EUR 165) a year/person.

Students will receive the above-mentioned allowances as long as they have active student status at the allocated host institution. As mentioned before, the scholarship holders will also receive information about these details and obligations by email.
